## This funding will be used to

- Increase the % of students in the U2Bs for Reading above SQSS
- Ensure 95% of students reach NMS for Reading
- Ensure 90% of indigenous students reach NMS for Reading
- Ensure 85% of students achieve a C or above in English across all year levels
- Ensure 90% of students achieve regional reading targets

## Our initiatives include

- Implementation of whole school reading and writing program
- Employ additional classroom teaching positions to reduce class sizes
- Employ additional speech language pathology services
- Implement year level case management approach to supporting identified students
- Implement enhanced speech therapy for identified students
- Collect & analyse Early Start data to inform intervention
- Collaborative planning sessions for teachers each term
